

Duke Talent Identification Program

A parent/guardian can complete the entire process online without the school involvement at <https://tip.duke.edu>. Students can meet requirements for enrollment in one of three ways:

1. 95%ile on any accepted subtest or total battery/composite on a grade-level standardized achievement test from 3rd through 6th grade.
2. Score a minimum of a 125 on a full scale or composite score of an approved IQ test that is no more than two years old.
3. Gifted teacher recommendation (7th graders may have to refer to their 6th grade gifted teacher)

Fees:

There is a \$70 fee for enrollment. This covers the cost of taking one test early.
